This year celebrates how women rise together. Those are the most inspiring moments throughout time: when we can reach into each other's lives and affect positive change.



CHRISTINA'S STORY

When I first found myself pregnant as a young woman, I was nervous about raising another human. Then another challenge hit when my youngest was still in diapers and I became a single mom.

What followed after having my second daughter, was a deep, dark, post-partum depression that I didn't know how to address. I was trying to keep my world afloat and raise my daughters the best way I knew how, but my corner felt empty. I felt alone. Even after I reached out for help and did the work, I felt myself slipping back. Then I discovered a lifeline: Kaleo.

I always say I wish I had found Kaleo sooner. This village of women is so empowering and welcoming. I knew I wanted to do more to help Kaleo Collective, so I started volunteering my time, raising donations, befriending other moms. I helped whenever it was needed and I soon became a shoulder for many other women who needed love and support.

Through Kaleo, I met one of my very closest friends.

Together we created the Single Parent Podcast, a
platform for all single parents to get advice, hear
stories, attain resources and be a part of a community.

This experience has shown me that my losses are a part
of a journey that so many single parents share.

All of this has been possible thanks to Kaleo.
Ultimately, I want to see other single parents get help sooner rather than later. I want them to find their community. We truly are all in this together.



PROGRAMS & SERVICES

Kaleo Collective welcomes all single mothers who want to be a part of our community, and we are deeply committed to serving them and their children. In 2021, these women spent 2,125 hours in Kaleo programming. In just a few years, we have grown to help more than 2,000 women and kids from St. Albert and beyond. We provide a safe, supportive environment that teaches practical life skills to create positive habits, break unhealthy cycles and open doors to personal and career development opportunities.

MAKE IT!

In its second year, this mom-favourite program helped bring families together through art. This year also welcomed 26 kids into a special painting class with renowed artist Lewis Lavoie. Made possible by donations, this rare opportunity allowed little ones to explore their creative side and make a gift for mom.

Over the year, we held three events with 120 women and

children participating.

MEALS FOR MAMA

This unique programs gives moms a free meal from Central Social Hall and time to bond together as a family. Now in its second year, Meals For Mama is an in-demand program, filling up every month offered.





LAUNCH YOUR LIFE

Led by a living success story, Kaleo Mom Noel Murdoch gives women the insight, confidence and skills to navigate a new path. In its first offering, this new course sold out and has now become a signature offering of Kaleo programming.

PROGRAMS & SERVICES

THE SINGLE MOM RESOURCE COURSE

Navigating through a another pandemic year, Kaleo had both online and in-person offerings in 2021, with continued impressive growth and expanded reach. Despite changing covid-19 regulations and challenges, the ease of online delivery opened Kaleo's doors to a new group of women who have become a part of this growing community. The program's results continue to show incredible value for those women who participate. In total for 2021, these women devoted **522 hours of skill development** in the course.

100% OF WOMEN REPORTED THAT SINGLE MOM RESOURCE COURSE ADDED VALUE TO THEIR LIVES

83% reported an increase in their capability to take action on improving their lives

75% reported an increase in their time management skills

77% reported an increase in their budgeting skills

81% reported an increased awareness between the connection of mental and physical wellbeing

96% reported increased skills and knowledge of strategies for managing stress

78% increased their confidence in the steps need to vision the future they want for themselves

PROGRAMS & SERVICES

SINGLE MOM SUPPORT GROUP

With belonging at its core, the single mom support group welcomes all women into this weekly meet-up to discuss topics relevant to the journey of a single mom. Here women create their own support network, develop new skills and learn ways to make life easier. But the greater impact is how this community helps single moms on their mission to living a life they love and to help their children do the same.

Meetings now spotlight a local mom, giving her the opportunity to share her story. Ranging from business owners to personal success stories, each featured woman has become a leader in her own right, rising up within the Kaleo community to a place where her story inspires others. Participant numbers vary week to week, while our core group of moms continues to grow. This past year, we welcomed more than **125** women to our Single Mom Support Group.



Building on the tremendous success of last year, Kaleo experienced its **largest growth year in 2021** with 1,184 women and children taking part in programming, events and the Kaleo community. Since beginning in 2016, more than 2,000 women and children have joined Kaleo, strengthening their families and the community.

PROGRAMS & SERVICES

THE GRIEF & TRAUMA HEALING CENTRE

2021 continued our strong partnership with The Grief & Trauma Healing Centre. Kaleo's focus is on empowering the whole woman, and this new partnership with a team of registered psychologists provided the tools to help our moms on the pathway to healing.

Led by Ashley Mielke B.A., M.Sc.MFT, The Grief & Trauma Healing Centre has generously provided specialized group programs at a rate that reduces cost barriers for our moms, as well as a sliding scale for individual therapy sessions.

On April 17th, Kaleo's annual fundraising event grew exponentially with **donations increasing** by an astounding 400% and attendance by more than 300%.

This overwhelming support from community supporters secured programming and special outreach for our clients, including the first Kids Make It art class with Lewis Lavoie!

With fundraising goals surpassed that night, the community lit up the night for those who needed it most and are often overlooked.






KALEO EVENTS




IN THE NEWS







THE SINGLE MOM SISTERHOOD FACEBOOK GROUP






